

CAIRNS HOCKEY FACILITY AND INFUSTRUCTURE MANAGEMENT ADVISORY GROUP – TERMS OF REFERENCE

- 1. The Cairns Hockey Association Facility Management Advisory Group provides advice and recommendations to the General Manager-Operations and CHA Board on the following:
 - a. Cairns North Hockey Facility including pitches and improvements
 - b. Plans and Budgets.
 - c. Stakeholder engagement with Cairns Regional Council, contractors, and other specialists from time to time.
- 2. In advising the General Manager-Operations and the Board, this Advisory Group will have regard to:
 - a. financial implications of the advice, where relevant
 - b. the impact on players, officials, and volunteers
 - c. the impact of CHA operational requirements
 - d. the current and future needs of CHA.
- 3. The General Manager-Operations or the Board may refer a matter to this Advisory Group for consideration and advice.
- 4. The General Manager-Operations or the Board may take the advice of the Advisory Group into account in making a decision on a matter.
- 5. Indoor Advisory Group recommendations will be made through producing minutes, and these minutes, including the recommendations, be submitted to the Board through General Manager-Operations for attention in a timely manner.
- 6. The General Manager-Operations will report final decisions of relevant matters to the Advisory Group.
- 7. The Advisory Group will meet when necessary.
- 8. A simple majority of members is needed to support a motion of advice to the General Manager-Operations or the CHA Board. Dissenting views may be recorded at the discretion of the Chair.
- 9. The CHA Facilities Advisory Group comprises:
 - a. Chair
 - b. 3 appointed representatives with the required skill
 - c. Invited members
- 10. Minutes of meetings will be recorded and kept on file in the CHA office.
